STRANDED IN SHANGHAI: THE HONGKONG GHETTO THROUGH THE EYES OF REFUGEES AND THE LENS OF ARTHUR ROTHSTEIN – In April 1946, prominent American photojournalist Arthur Rothstein took twenty-two photos that captured the living conditions of Jewish refugees in the Chinese city of Shanghai.
